



2026 Tire & Handicap Procedures

Super Late Models:

Handicap Procedure: Teams will draw for heat race position; Feature lineups will be set by heat race finishes. After week one, previous winners and new cars cannot start inside the top 70% of the field.

Tires: Teams will buy 4 tires on the first week and be allowed 2 per week after that. New cars will be allowed to buy 4 tires and required to put 50 Laps and 2 heat cycles on 2 of their race tires. Teams will not be allowed to bank tires; New tires must be raced the night they are bought.

Street Stocks, Ridge Runners, Six Shooters and Crown Vics:

Handicap Procedures: Teams will draw for heat race position week one and go into a 3-week handicap average after that. New Cars, and teams that miss an event, will receive full handicap points for events missed.

Ridge Runner and Street Stock Tire Rule: Teams will be allowed 4 tires opening day and 1 per week after that. Teams must race in the heat and feature to be allowed a tire the following week. Teams are allowed to bank new tires and run them as they please.

Small Block, 350 Super Modifieds:

Handicap Procedures: Teams will draw for heat race position, feature lineups will be set by heat race finishes. Previous winners and new cars will not be permitted to start inside the top five.

Tire Rule: Teams will be allowed 4 tires on opening day and 2 per event after that. Teams will be allowed 3 tires at the Ollie Silva Midsummer Classic and Oktoberfest.

Note: *No chemical treatment allowed, all tires in all divisions are subject to lab testing.*
